These can include one of the phrases given in the Lectionary*:

Praise to you, O Christ, King of eternal glory.

Praise and honour to you, Lord Jesus!

Glory and praise to you O Christ!

Glory to you, O Christ, you are the Word of God!

Please note: Do not hymns during Lent that contain the word "Alleluia!"
